

In Memory of Michael L. Duffy

March 17, 1950 - January 21, 2022

Michael "Mike" Duffy, Chairman of the Board and former CEO and President of Per Mar Security Services, passed away on January 21, 2022. Per Mar could not have asked for a better leader, nor employees a better friend, nor his family a more loving patriarch than Mike Duffy. He was a man of great faith, a devoted husband, father and grandfather, and an incredible leader within the company, the greater community and the security industry at large. Mike didn't know a stranger - always treating others with kindness and respect.



Per Mar was founded by Mike's parents, John and Eleanor Duffy, in Davenport, Iowa, in 1953. Even as a young boy, Mike wanted to be a part of the fledgling company. At the age of five, he made his own security badge and dressed up like a detective. A few years later, he was taking care of the company's German Shepherd guard dogs, and before Mike finished high school, he was working third shift as a dispatcher.

Due to his father's declining health, Mike became President and CEO of Per Mar in 1977 - at the age of 28. In his 44-year span of leadership that followed, the company completed more than 80 acquisitions of life safety companies, eventually becoming the largest family-owned, full-service security provider in the Midwest. Mike felt it was important to continually invest in the company and, most importantly, Per Mar's employees. He believed that taking care of employees would lead to good customer service and in the end, excellent results for the company.

Mike and his wife, Linda, raised seven children who have already provided them with thirty-three grandchildren (and counting). Mike raised his children to only patronize Per Mar customers, even checking credit card statements of his teen drivers to ensure that they filled up at gas stations with Per Mar alarms. Mike was known for his sense of humor and modeled humility by introducing himself as an "alarm salesman" while on vacation with his family.

Mike worked to express appreciation for others, keeping a long list of birthdays that he recognized with cards and \$2 bills. He also quietly took care of larger needs for long-time employees, at times covering items like funeral costs, travel to see dying parents, or a once-in-a-lifetime trip for a terminally ill employee. It was sacrosanct to Mike that employees at all levels of the company be treated with respect, and he remained accessible to all employees and customers even as the company grew.

Mike worked to do the right thing in his personal and professional life. One of his greatest joys was giving back. Under his leadership, Per Mar started an employee charity fund, which has since donated \$1.52 million to local not-for-profit organizations in our operating areas. Additionally, Mike gave significantly through a family foundation that he initiated. During his lifetime, Mike served on numerous boards in the security industry and many more in his community.

Always viewing himself as a steward of the family business, Mike achieved a lifelong goal by transitioning company leadership well before his passing. Per Mar, now in its third generation of family leadership, is led by Mike's sons Brad and Brian Duffy.

"My father had an extremely positive impact on so many people – employees along with others. I cannot tell you how many times I've heard secondhand stories of his private acts of kindness. Words cannot begin to do justice to the person he was," said Brian Duffy. "My dad loved Per Mar - especially seeing people grow with the company. On the personal side, my siblings and I could not have hoped for a better team than my mother and father. They have done their best to prepare us to fill their shoes as parents, and now, business partners."
