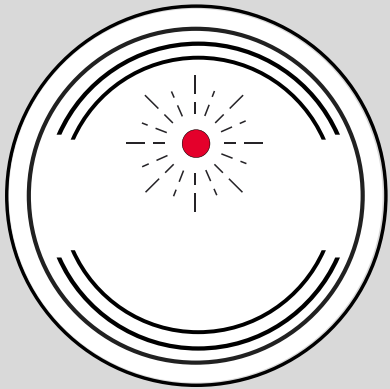


CARBON MONOXIDE

WINTER SAFETY TIPS



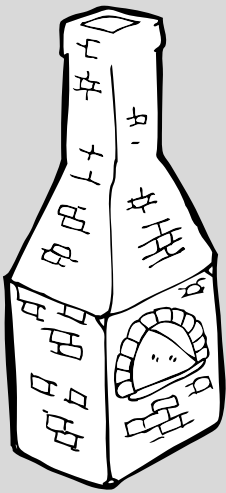
1 CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

Install carbon monoxide detectors in your home, even if your state doesn't require it.



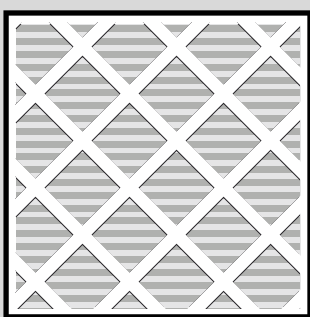
2 SNOW

Keep outdoor vent areas shoveled (vents from your furnace or gas dryer are most common).



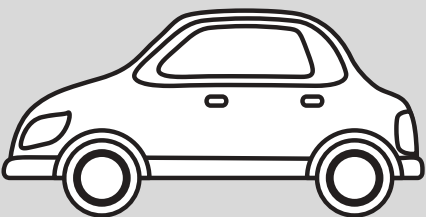
3 ANNUAL SERVICE

Service your chimney, furnace, water heater and any gas or coal-burning appliances annually by a certified and reputable company.



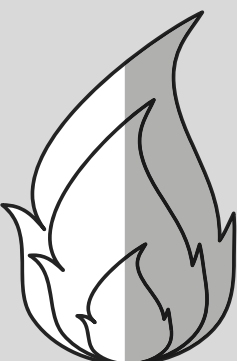
4 FURNACE FILTERS

Change your HVAC filters before winter starts (it's not too late to do it now).



5 VEHICLES

Do not warm up your car if it's in the garage (even if the garage door is open), especially an attached garage.



6 HOME HEAT

NEVER heat your home with a gas appliance. Generators, portable flameless chemical heaters, or gas camp stoves are not to be used inside.
